What have we achieved?

We have learned a lot just by following our partners and staying with them. The Danish kids thought that it was strange that we drove to school even though we lived like 2 minutes away. They also thought we are more connected to the nature. The Icelandic kids thought that living in Copenhagen is a lot different because there are a lot of people there and you can travel between places quickly.

We think that there is also a lot more diversity socially in Denmark and more kids to socialize with. The different between the countries geographically is huge for example Denmark doesn't have any mountains. A lot of the Danish kids hadn't been to Iceland before so they saw a lot of new things and for example didn't expect the country to be so big and that you could drive for so long around it. We think that we have maybe gotten a little bit better at English just by speaking it. The Danish kids learned about the global goals a lot by staying here and seeing how the global warming affects us and by hearing us talk about it. We had done a little project about the global goals before the visit and there we learned a lot about the United Nations and the goals that we hadn't learned before. The Icelandic kids had never heard about the concept "efterskole" so it was fun seeing how that works because it is really different from what we have in our school system.

The project work in the groups went well and the Danish students thought it was fun to film and see all the places we filmed at. We finished the project without much trouble.
